The WOH education classes engage the imagination as well as enhance personal communication, critical thinking, teamwork, and collaboration skills. The program is composed of two nine week sessions. Each session is focused on a different and integrated course of study in the theatre arts. The classes are designed to be age appropriate. The Dance Education Program runs September through May and will emphasize technique and age-appropriate curriculum.

Dance Education Program

The Woodland Opera House Dance Program will emphasize foundational techniques of classical ballet, tap and jazz. Classes are held Sept.-May.

Open House Showcases—on stage - May 21 at 7pm

Pre-Ballet: For the first time student. An introduction to ballet, movement and rhythm.

Ages 3-4 Rose Group **Mondays 2:45-3:30**

Ages 5-6 Pink Group **Weds. 3:45-4:30**

Beginning Ballet: For the student with little or no previous experience. Introduction to basic ballet positions of feet, arms, and head. Emphasis on body posture and rhythm.

Ages 4-6 Blue Group **Weds. 4:45-5:30**

Ages 7-10 Green Group **Mon. 3:45-4:45***

Ages 7-10 Purple Group **Weds. 5:45-6:45**

Ages 11-Adult **Sat. 10:35-11:35***

Intermediate Ballet: Classes will focus on improving strength, flexibility and control and on learning combinations. Teacher permission is required.

Ages 7-10 - Yellow Group **Tues. & Thurs. 3:45-4:45**

Ages 11-adult- Red Group **Tues. & Thurs 4:50-5:50**

Advanced Ballet: Classes will focus on improving strength, flexibility and control and on learning more complicated combinations. Teacher permission is required.

Ages 11-Adult- **Thursday 5:50- 7:00**

Lyrical: An introduction to lyrical dance. Emphasis on technique and intermediate combinations.

Previous Ballet II or higher or Intermediate Jazz .

Ages 10- Adult **Saturdays 11:40-12:40**

Underlined: NEW CLASSES NOW FORMING

Beginning Tap This class is an introduction to basic tap steps and combinations.

Ages 7-10 **Saturdays—9:30-10:30**

Tap III: For the continuing student. Emphasis on tap combinations.

Ages 8-Adult **Tuesdays 6:00-7:00**

Intermediate Tap: Emphasis on technique and combinations. Teacher permission is required.

Ages 10-Adult **Mondays- 6:00-7:00**

Jazz I: For the beginning student with little or no previous jazz dance. Introduction to technique and combinations.

Ages 7-10 **Fridays—3:45-4:45**

Ages 11- Adult **Fridays—4:50-5:50**

Intermediate Jazz: For the returning student.

This class will focus on strength, flexibility and intermediate combinations. Teacher permission is required.

Ages 10-Adult **Mondays- 4:50-5:50**

Dress code: Ballet & lyrical

Girls: black leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers and hair in a bun.

Boys: black tights, a white t-shirt and black ballet slippers.

Tap & Jazz:

Girls and boys: Dance pants or sweat pants, T-shirt. Jazz shoes/Tap shoes
